This was a share session, and a variety of pieces kept our attention. We first looked at a couple of photo albums that Roger had saved from recycling. A couple of the faces looked familiar, a couple of the places looked local, but, with no identification, the album had little meaning. We were going to track down some more clues. However, this event is a reminder for all of us to imagine future residents having possession of our photo albums and being (un)able to know who or what is in the photo album. Most of us, based on the feedback I heard, are guilty of not labeling or identifying.

Martha Turon brought in old photos of Ronald Reagan, collected before he became politically famous. His death was a chance to briefly note his accomplishments and our memories of him.

Janet Kiefer, through a well placed comment from Pat Lambe, gave copies of the 1981, 1982, 1987-1990 Pioneer Yearbooks. These books were part of her brother Joe-Joe's collection; Joe-Joe was kiddingly called a perpetual graduate of GCS, with his signed copies of a string of yearbooks. Thank you, Pat and Janet.

The holes in the yearbook collection are 1946, 1950, 1951, and 1952. If you

know of anyone who may be willing to pass along a yearbook or yearbooks of those years, please keep the historian's files in mind.

A welcome went to the three newcomers – Carol, Jeannette and Nettie. Carol has been a member of the GLHG since its inception. Carol noted the building of a new home on Ingalside Road, and we got sidetracked into talking about early memories of the residents and residences of that road, with help from Walter and Harriett and a few others. Stories of Art Howe were a common theme. (For those of us present, Jesus Saves Eggs evoked a chuckle or two.)

Harriett brought a WWII Memorial photo and caption honoring Cas' service. She also contributed to the files a Stanton Insurance card and 1980 calendar card.

Don had clipped a recent Daily Mail article on the naming of Town of Cairo roads after residents killed in action during WWI (Joel Austin, Vernal Butler, Joseph Chadderdon, Floyd Hawver, Frank Hitchcock). The article also mentioned other roads named after WWII vets (Harold Meyer, H.M. Chadderdon, Edison Timmerman), and then some more roads named after residents (Joseph Holzmann, Joseph Kollar, Ira Vail, Rudolph Weir, Warren Stein, Ross Ruland, William Dinger).

This then got us Greenvillians to recite the list of roads named after families. We came up with Turon, Weed, King Hill, Scutt, O'Hara, Ingalside, Garland, Irving, Carter Bridge, and Waldron. (What

about Drake Hill and Shipley?) As far as we can ascertain, none are listed after a particular person.

Don brought out the "people" photo albums, asking if anyone could find a photo that should be in a local history calendar sometime soon.

Walter brought in an album of post-cards of the area, mostly of the Durham and Oak Hill area.

Gail Banker sent a copy of a Clear-view Speedway Official Program, parts of which I have reproduced for your perusal, both of the programs and of the ads.

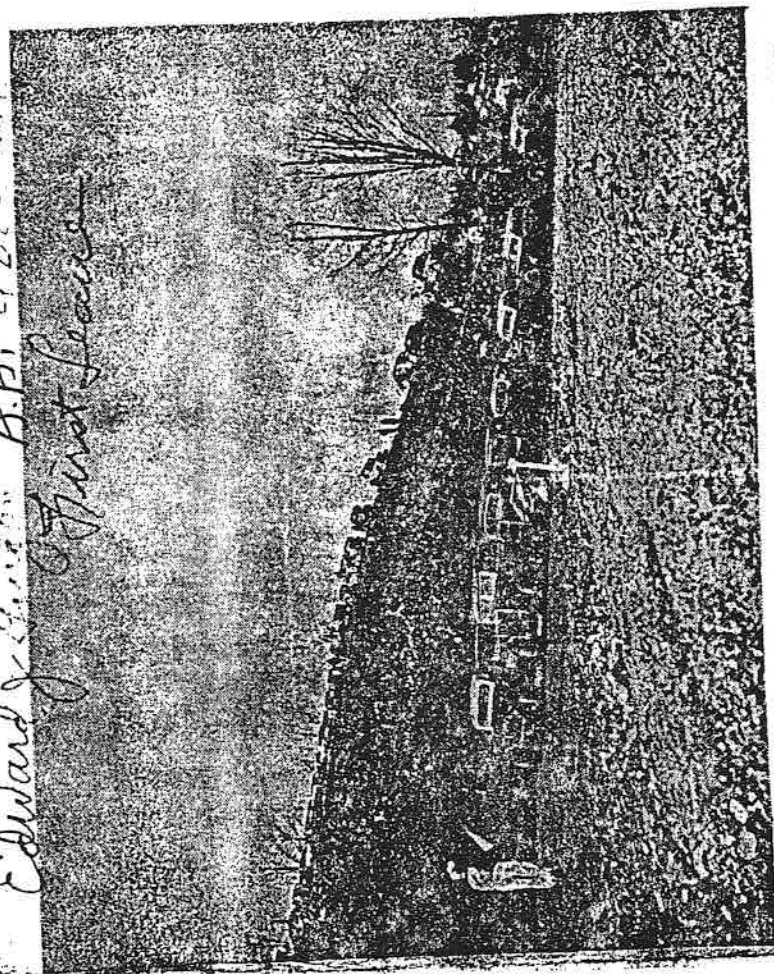
