

February 24, 1992

The February 10th GLHG meeting featured a program, put on by Don Teator, of the published sources that document and describe the history, life styles, and people of Greenville.

Copies of the three page agenda, as well as copies of selected material from sources, were distributed. The material ranges from the usual historical county guides to the publication of specific event material. A brief description of each of the sources was given.

The usual sources of Town of Greenville history and people include:
